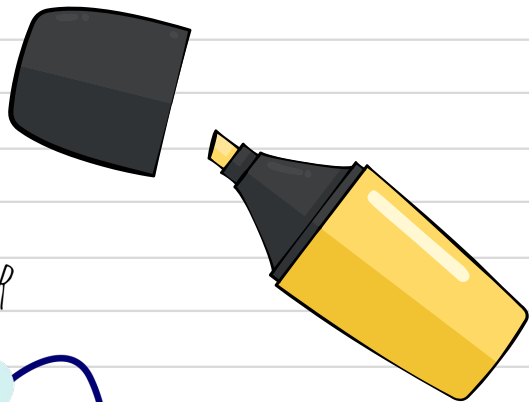
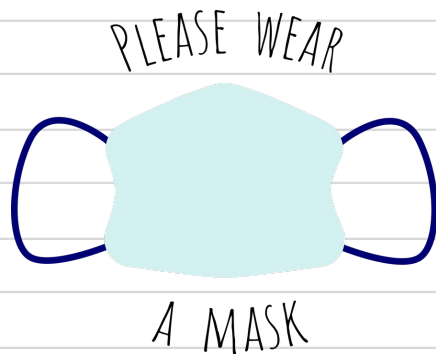

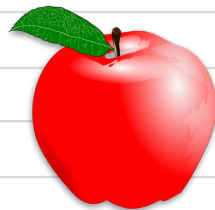

- On **Thursdays and Fridays - Cohort A and Distance Learners** will log on and do the assigned worked.

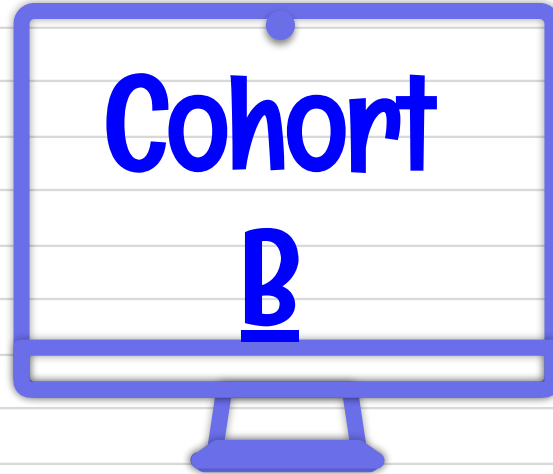

Independent Reading

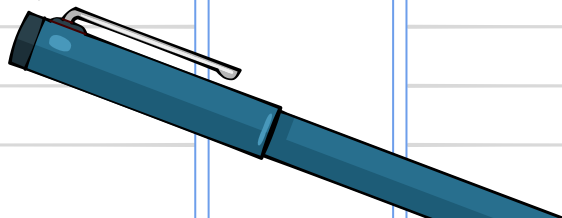


Your child should read for 20 minutes 5 days a week, outside of school. There are multiple ways to get your child to engage in reading.

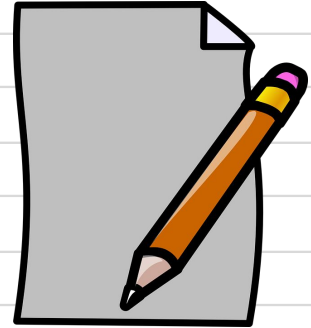

Fundations is the phonics/spelling program that we use.

The program consists of the following 6 components:

- Phonemic Awareness
- Phonics and Word Study
- Vocabulary Development
- Reading Fluency
- Comprehension Strategies
- Spelling and Handwriting

Parent letters will go home with your child at the beginning of each unit to inform you of what we will be covering in that unit.

There will not be a weekly spelling test. At the end of each unit there is an assessment that will be given to monitor student progress.
